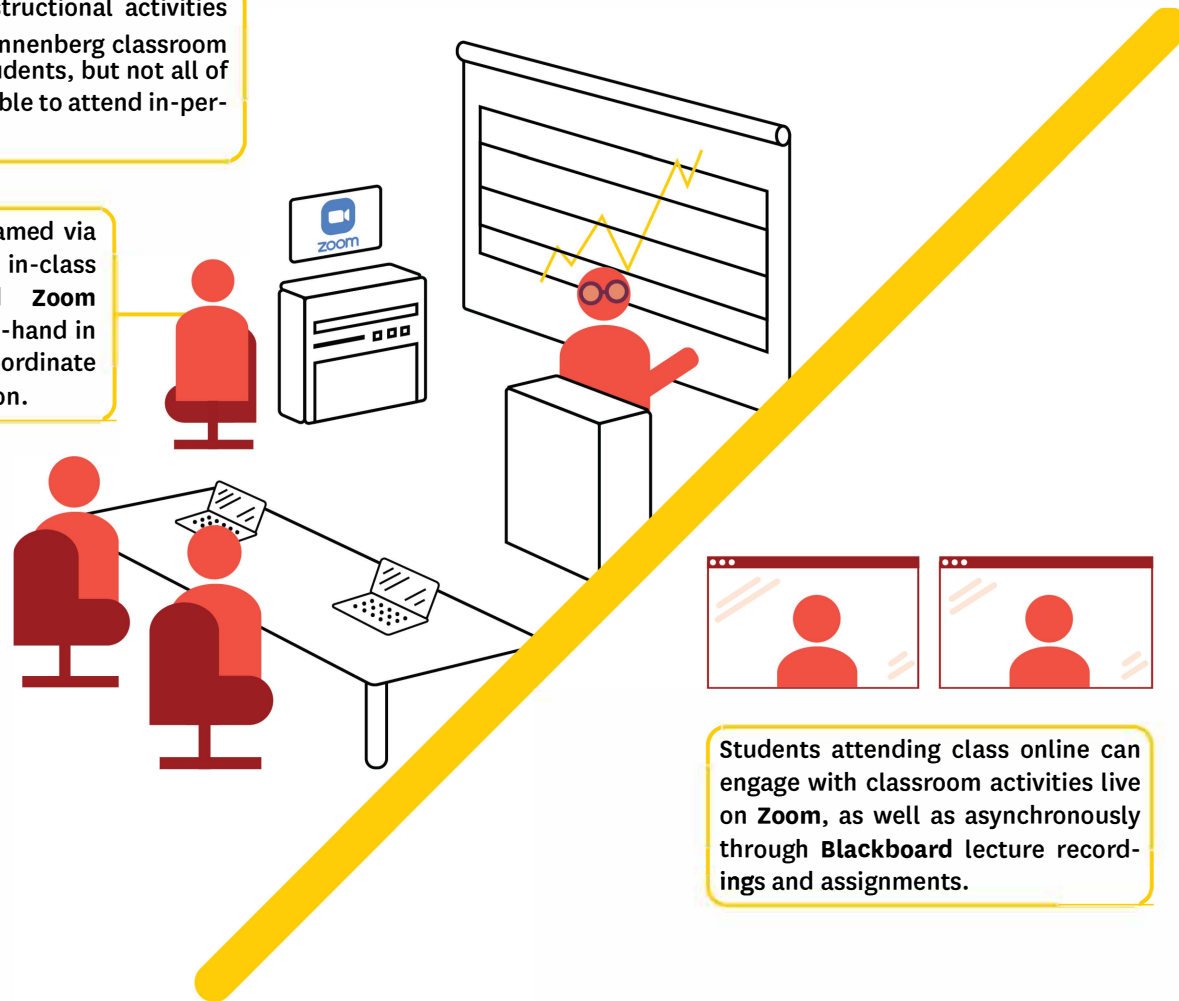


## Hybrid/Flex Modality

Here, primary instructional activities take place in an Annenberg classroom with in-person students, but not all of the students are able to attend in-person.

Lectures are streamed via Zoom using in-class equipment, and **Zoom Assistants** are on-hand in each class to coordinate online participation.



Students attending class online can engage with classroom activities live on **Zoom**, as well as asynchronously through **Blackboard** lecture recordings and assignments.



If learning objectives require access to on-campus facilities, most of the section's students meet in-person, on-campus – but the instructor may have to “remote in” via Zoom from their home.



Faculty use Zoom to lecture live to the students on-campus via in-class projectors and cameras. **Zoom Assistants** are on-hand in each class to coordinate in-class and online participation.
